



Tindale Online Search Instructions

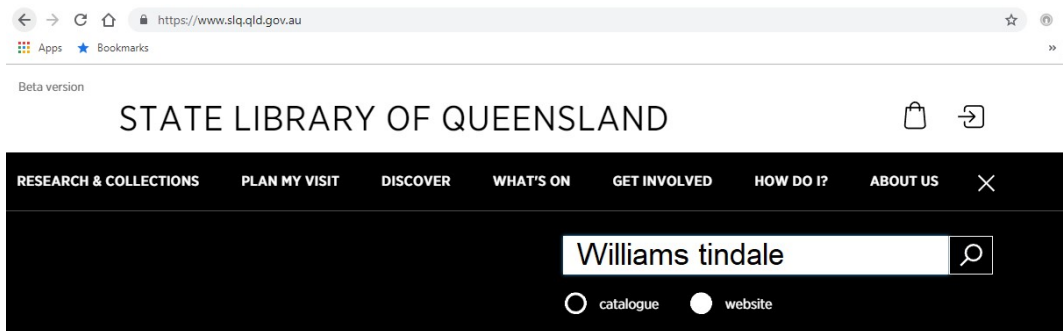
1. Visit the State Library of Queensland internet site at <https://www.slq.qld.gov.au/>
2. Under the title "RESEARCH & COLLECTIONS" "ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER COLLECTION" and click on the "Tindale Genealogical Collection" site at <https://www.slq.qld.gov.au/research-collections/family-history/aboriginal-and-torres-strait-islander-people/tindale>
3. Using the Tindale Genealogical Collection and follow the prompts to view the online index of names in the genealogies on the One Search catalogue.

Then genealogies relate to people that had **volunteered their information** from Cherbourg (QLD); Mona Mona (QLD); Palm Island (QLD); Woorabinda (QLD); Bentinck Island (QLD) ; Doomadgee (QLD); Mornington Island (QLD); Boggabilla (NSW) & Woodenbong (NSW) missions, thus not all family's are held on this collection.

The below example will assist you to getting started in this process, type in your Surname example "Williams" with "tindale" to gain access to the results found on this Surname.

This catalogue process was created to allow remote Queenslander access to names mentioned in this collection only. Family trees will not present themselves online as there are accession conditions to follow.

After the paperwork is completed a four-day maximum turn-a-round time.



Tindale sheet will provide information obtained by Norman Tindale in **1938**, making the information over 80year old. Thus, you need to be searching for great-grandparents or people living before this time-frame.

Community - Sheet number - Negative Number

4. **Tindale Queries** form .. remembering that
- information for family members only
 - Identification and client signature is required.
 - Family tree provided should be filled in showing relationship to named people.
 - Must have community name and number.
 - You do not have to fill in all family names for one sheet eg
 - It is important to write down Negative Numbers.

Native Title claims follow a different format. Land councils are given free access to all the Tindale collection, once they have provided a letterhead stating that they would like to view the collection. Photocopies of sheets are only provided when a claims form with specific names and sheets number are provided [on a letter head]. This is the procedure demonstrated by the South Australian Museum [**legal custodians of this collection**].
